SHAME ON YOU

BRO. WALLACE LITTLE
I CORINTHIANS 15:34

“I speak this to your shame”, God says, “Shame on you”. God is speaking to the sons of men in awful rebuke (Ps. 4:2). It is a gift from God to see that you have done something that is shameful, that you need to be ashamed about. (Dan. 12:2)

“We are ashamed for the wrong reasons today, we are ashamed of Jesus but we are not ashamed of sin.”

I. Shame on you that sleep.

A. Sleep of backslider—indifferent (Rom. 13:10-14)

*“Christianity is more than going to church,
Christianity is **being** the church.”*

B. Sleep of death—the lost (Lk. 19:10, I Cor. 2:14)

The lost man is in the dark. Oh, but glory to God, Jesus can raise the dead! He is who says, “Awake! Awake to Righteousness and sin not”. If you will open your heart to Jesus, He will raise you from the dead spiritually.

II. Shame on you that still practice sin.

Shame on you that say you are saved and yet live a life dirty with sin. If sin doesn't bother you then you might not be a child of God at all.

“You can bring a nightmare on yourself if you get into sin.”

III. Shame on you that have not a personal knowledge of Jesus Christ. (Matt. 7:22-23, Jn. 10:14, 26-30, II Tim. 1:12)

It is a interpersonal relationship when you get saved. You are one of His sheep.

IV. Shame on you that have no burden for souls.

(Ps. 142: 4, 126: 6)
